PUBLIC SAFETY:

- Support LAPD and LAFD with no budget and staffing cuts.
- Emergency Preparedness – support and fund community emergency preparedness efforts.

QUALITY OF LIFE ISSUES:

- Support the Neighborhood Prosecutor Program (responds to neighborhood issues/complaints and addresses criminal problems proactively to preserve our quality of life).
